



2023 SEASON INFO - JUNIOR MEMBERS

We cater for junior players of primary and intermediate school age who want to learn and play hockey.

What grades we offer

Juniors play in grades based on their school year per the Hockey NZ Small Sticks guidelines. Years 1-2 participate in our Fun Sticks programme (mixed), and year 3-8 (boys & girls) play in the Canterbury Hockey Association (CHA) Junior Competition against other local Clubs and schools.

In 2022 we entered 20 teams, 13 girls' and seven boys' teams.

Fun Sticks (Years 1 & 2): Fun Sticks is an exciting hands-on hockey programme that aims to introduce five and six-year-olds to hockey. The emphasis is on having fun whilst developing fundamental skills.

Where: Sand turf, Foster Park, Rolleston **When:** Friday 4 pm - 5 pm (Term Time only), for 16 weeks, starts on 28 April 2023, with the last session on 25 August 2023.

Mini Sticks (Years 3 & 4): A 6-a-side competition played on a quarter turf. This competition is about learning to play hockey. Players start to get a feel for what the game of hockey is like while enjoying themselves and learning new skills!

Where: The girl's games are played across various hockey turfs around Christchurch, the *boy's games are played at a central venue in Christchurch. Practice takes place at Foster Park. In 2022.

When: The girl's games are Saturday mornings and the *boy's games are on a Friday evening. Practice is after school during the week. Training times confirmed when teams are confirmed.

Format: Games 12 minutes each way. Play on 1/4 of a turf. *Please note, still TBC by CHA for the 2023 season.



Kiwi Sticks (Years 5 & 6): A step up from mini sticks. They play games on half a turf. The rules of the game come more into play. Goalkeepers can be optional in this grade.

Where: They play games across various school hockey turfs around Christchurch. Practice takes place at Foster Park.

When: Games are on Saturday mornings. Practice takes place during the week. Training times will be confirmed when teams are confirmed.

Format: Games are 18 minutes each way, 1/2 turf

Kwik Sticks (Years 7 & 8): The 2022 competition offered nine weeks of 7-a-side hockey before the Year 8 players had the opportunity to play five weeks of 11-a-side hockey in preparation for the years ahead as they venture into secondary school. *Please note we are waiting for confirmation from CHA for the 2023 season.*

When: They play games on Saturdays. Practice takes place during the week.

Where: They play games across various hockey turfs around Christchurch. Practice takes place at

Foster Park.

Format: 7-a-side play 3 x 15-minute on 1/2 turf. 11-a-side play 3x 19-minute thirds on a full turf.

Junior club programmes and events

Welcome back sessions (pre-season): A three-week pre-season programme. Open to all years 3-8 and a perfect opportunity to have pitch time before the season starts on the **NEW water turf**. Meet the coaches, catch up with friends, have a good run around, and freshen up your skills whilst enjoying yourselves. No need to book. Just turn up. The sessions will take place the last three Mondays of term 1- 20 & 27 March & 3 April. Mini Sticks (Years 3&4): 4pm-5pm. Kiwi Sticks (Years 5&6): 5pm-6pm and Kwik Sticks (Years 7&8): 6pm-7pm

New to Hockey sessions (pre-season): We offer a three-week pre-season Hockey Accelerator Programme (skills development) for players new to the game to help develop their basic skills. The sessions will focus on the first touch, position-specific skills, passing, hitting, tackling and ball handling. Open to years 5-8. The sessions will take place the last three Mondays of term 1-20 & 27 March & 3 April. No need to book. Just turn up. Two sessions are available 5pm – 6pm and 6pm – 7pm on the sand turf.

Junior Club Day (new for 2023 season): Join us for the Junior Club Day. As we kick off an exciting new season. Get to meet and play with your team. Meet other Waikirikiri teams, your coach, and the committee, and pick up your uniform. Sausage sizzle, and Just Hockey stall. Bring along the whole family and invite your friends. **Sunday, 26 March** – Save the date!

Hockey Accelerator Programme (skills development): for players who want extra time on the pitch to help develop their basic skills. Perfect for those new to hockey and those who want to further develop their basics. The sessions will focus on the first touch, position-specific skills, passing, hitting, tackling and ball handling. Open to years 5-8. The sessions take place on the **sand turf** on a **Monday night**. There are two sessions available **5pm – 6pm** or **6pm – 7pm**. Term Time only. **No need to book. Just turn up.** See the dates below. **Term 2:** 1 May – 26 June (9 weeks) & **Term 3:** 17 July – 14 August (5 weeks)

Junior Umpire Development Programme: The best place to start umpiring for years 7-10 is umpiring Kiwi Sticks grades. The games are on a Saturday morning at Foster Park. The Junior Umpire Club Mentor provides full training and support for new umpires, coordinates the roster, and works the Umpire's Roster around the junior umpire's games (so they don't miss out on playing). Goalkeeper Training: Will run alongside the Hockey Accelerator Programme on a Monday night on the sand turf. No need to book. Just turn up. You will need to bring your own goalkeeping kit or borrow your team's goalkeeping kit. Open to years 5-8. The sessions take place on the sand turf on a Monday night. There are two sessions available 5pm – 6pm or 6pm – 7pm. Term Time only. No need to book. Just turn up. See the dates below. Uniform & equipment



Fun Sticks: The club provides hockey sticks and balls. Equipment needed - mouthguard and shinpads (compulsory), soft-soled shoes – trainers or turf shoes only, shorts or track pants, t-shirt, long socks, warm top to start.

New to Hockey - purchase a **junior hockey starter pack** from Just Hockey and **save over 30%**. www.justhockey.co.nz/page/starter-pack-quide.

Years 3 - 8: Years 3 - 8: Require a mouthguard and shin pads (no mouthguard or shinpads, no game or practice), water bottle, clean-soled soft shoes - trainers or turf shoes only and hockey stick. The club supplies playing tops. The tops are distributed to players before the first game and collected in the last game of the season. A uniform bond is charged and added to registration fees. All bond money will be returned to players, upon return of the tops, in line with the uniform and equipment policy. Club socks are navy. You can buy these from <u>Just Hockey</u>. Shorts and Skorts, the club are looking into a new supplier. TBC for the 2023 season.

Team placings

Waikirikiri Hockey selects teams in alignment with Hockey New Zealand and Canterbury Hockey Association guidance which focuses on participation and enjoyment in the younger years with increased levels of emphasis on teamwork and skills development as the players move up the grades, leading to performance at the senior level. Coaches focus on technical skills development, rules observance, teamwork, involvement, and positioning to prepare players for the next level.

We group players in teams according to several factors; their school year, the team they were in previously, ability, skill, and school. If you're new to the club, let us know on the registration form who you have played for previously and or your level of skill and ability.

When allocating teams, we will consider siblings, transportation issues and parental involvement. Please note any carpooling arrangement on your registration form. Please be mindful that these are only requests, and we can't always meet these requests.
